Title: Program Director- Children, Youth, and Intergenerational Ministries Director 0.35 FTE* 14 hours/week

Purpose:

To develop and direct the program ministry of the congregation's children and youth and to participate in the full ministry of the congregation.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Together with the Children, Youth, and Family Committee Develop/Select programming and content for the educational ministry for infants through senior high school students.
- 2. Encourage and recruit educational volunteers to participate in programs and lead classes.
- 3. Train volunteers in the Church's Safe Church policy and ensure that it is being followed.
- 4. Serve as resource person to the Christian Education Ministry team and assist the team in implementing committee goals.
- 5. Collaborate with the program staff to ensure achievement of church program objectives; attend staff meetings.
- 6. Coordinate classroom usage with church office and week-day ministries.
- 7. Support/Assist planning and implementing intergenerational programs/events.

Relationships:

- 1. Work cooperatively with Pastors and staff to provide Confirmation program for youth.
- 2. Serve as staff liaison and resource person for Christian Education Ministry Team.
- 3. The Session is ultimately responsible for the educational ministry of the Church. The Christian Education Director assists in implementing the educational ministry.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 2 years in related field.
- Faith and belief in concert with principles, teachings, and tenets of Reformed Theology.
- Create open and welcoming community for *all* children and families; especially those with LGBTQ+ members, traditionally unserved populations, and those with learning/developmental disabilities.
- Ability to recruit, motivate, support, and guide volunteers and assigned staff.
- Demonstrated skill in curriculum implementation, teaching methodologies, classroom instruction, human development, and learning modalities.

- Strong interpersonal and communications skills.
- Bachelor's or higher degree in related field, or equivalent.

Accountability:

The Christian Education Director is accountable to the Session through the Head of Staff and Lead Pastor.

Evaluation:

A performance review will be conducted on an annual basis by the Head of Staff, representing the Personnel committee, and by a representative of the Christian Education Committee.

Compensation and Benefits:

The Session Personnel Committee will annually review the position's compensation and benefits.

*This position is 14 hours a week including Sundays.

This position could be paired with the half-time Corvallis Youth Collective Director position which is .5 FTE.
