





Accredited Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O) and Little Dengue Brigade Club shall be spearheading and strengthening student programs, projects and activities related to the control and prevention of the above-mentioned diseases. Furthermore, the SPG and SSG Vice President shall monitor and evaluate all related student-led PPAs and shall report these to the SPG/ SSG President.

Barangay Nurse/Midwife, and the CSWD 4Ps City Links shall conduct community education in coordination with the CENRO. In addition thereto, they shall have the following specific functions:

- 1) To motivate parents to seek early medical care for their sick children to prevent a serious outcome.
- 2) To raise the level of awareness of the dangers of the disease.
- 3) To challenge the community to take active role in prevention and control.
- 4) To disseminate information that is simple, easy to understand and clearly illustrated.
- 5) To outline benefits resulting from participation in community control activities.
- 6) To coordinate with the City Links in the dissemination of information during Family Development Session (FDS).

SECTION 11. CREATION OF THE SCHOOL ANTI-MOSQUITO-BORNE DISEASES TASK FORCE.

The School Anti-Mosquito-borne Diseases Task Force is hereby created hereinafter referred to as the "SAMDTF", which shall primarily support the City Government of Dasmariñas in its effort to fight Dengue, Chikungunya, Zika and Japanese Encephalitis.

SECTION 12. COMPOSITION OF SCHOOL ANTI-MOSQUITO-BORNE DISEASES TASK FORCE (SAMDTF).

The School Anti-Mosquito-borne Diseases Task Force (SAMDTF) shall be composed of following:

SECTION 13. FUNCTIONS OF SCHOOL ANTI-MOSQUITO-BORNE DISEASES TASK FORCE (SAMDTF).

The School Anti-Mosquito-borne Diseases Task Force (SAMDTF) in particular, shall:

- a) Initiate and oversee Anti-Dengue, Chikungunya, Zika and Japanese Encephalitis activities being undertaken by the school and its report shall be submitted to City Health Office (CHO).
